

Germany Study Tour

DAY 1 - MUNICH

Arrive in Munich and be transferred to the accommodation. Have a good rest before the tour begins the next day.

DAY 2 - MUNICH

This day you will learn about the Third Reich and World War II. The tour guide will take the group to few places where the Nazi had the first meetings and party rallies. Visit Hitler's Eagle's Nest: the tea house built for his 50th birthday. Educational tour of the Obersalzberg area. Lunch and dinner included.



DAY 3 - NUREMBERG

Start the morning heading to Dachau where the tour guide will take you to Dachau Memorial Camp. One of the first Concentration Camps, for an insight into the cruelty of the Nazi regime to the Jewish people. Spend time at the museum viewing the display of the Third Reich's rule and might. In Nuremberg visit the Documentation Centre, to see the permanent exhibition "Fascination and Terror" which concerned the causes, connections, and consequences of Nazi Germany. Final visit to the The Memorium Nuremberg Trials. Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

DAY 4 - DRESDEN

In the morning, we will start a quick drive by to see the various sites that Hitler used to hold the Nazi mass rallies: the Zeppelin Field, the Great Road, the German Stadium and the Congress Hall. Continue to Dresden to visit the Military History Museum. We will continue to visit the Volkswagen Glass Factory. This is the showcase factory of this famous German vehicle. Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

DAY 5 - BERLIN

Depart Dresden in the morning and travel towards to Potsdam. The first visit in Potsdam is the New Palace: erected under King Frederick II at the western end of Sanssouci Park the largest and most impressive palace ensemble in Sanssouci. Visit the site of the Potsdam Conference - Cecilienhof Palace. Quick stop at the Glienicke Bridge. Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

DAY 6 - BERLIN

Morning visit to the Jewish Museum. Third Reich walking tour that will take you to sites that include the Gestapo and SS Headquarters (now the Topography of Terror), Goering's Air Force HQ and the Propaganda Ministry. Visit to Topography of Terror: an outdoor museum, situated on the site of the SS and Gestapo headquarters during the Nazi regime. Pass by Holocaust Memorial. Brandenburg Gate. Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

DAY 7 - BERLIN

School visit in the morning. Various activities and lessons observation can be arranged. An alternative for youth interaction will be provided if a school visit is not possible. Visit to the German-Russian Museum. Last stop for the day will be a visit to the Berlin Wall (East Side Gallery). Most of the wall has been demolished; but this section remains as a special place. Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.



DAY 8 - BERLIN

Morning visit to The wall Museum at Checkpoint Charlie. Then head to The DDR Museum: an interactive museum in the centre of Berlin, that shows the daily life in East Germany (known in German as the Deutsche Demokratische Republik or DDR) in a direct "hands-on" way. In the late afternoon, we will visit Potsdamer Platz. This place was totally laid waste during World War II and then left desolate during the Cold War era when the Berlin Wall bisected its former location, but since the fall of the Wall it has risen again as a glittering new heart for the city and the most visible symbol of the new Berlin. Breakfast and dinner included.

DAY 9 - BERLIN / FRANKFURT

Depart Berlin this morning for Frankfurt. On the way, we will stop at a service station for lunch. Some free time for last minute souvenir hunting before we head to dinner and then to the airport. Breakfast, lunch and dinner included. Fly back to Australia
